

Oprah Winfrey is the most famous person who NEVER lived at Lake Point Tower. According to "Oprah Unbound" by Marcia Froelike Coburn in *Chicago Magazine*, December 2008:

"Since 1984, she has lived in Water Tower Place, in what is now a 15,000-square-foot duplex...Recently, she bought a 5,000-square-foot co-op on East Lake Shore Drive, one of the most exclusive addresses in the city. But she abandoned the idea of downsizing her Chicago duplex and moving there when she realized that residents from nearby apartments could see into her windows."

Long-time resident Marilyn Damon speculates the rumor about Lake Point Tower may have started during the building's conversion to help sell condos.
